Owner and Director of Bettie Jane's Center of Dance Art, Bettie Jane Bryant has served Frederick County for 60+years.

In the fall of 2008, Bettie Jane was diagnosed with breast cancer and had a double mastectomy at the end of October. She began Chemotherapy in December 2008 through March 2009 and had 28 radiation treatments in April/May 2009. She was an 11 year cancer survivor, but in March 2019, she was diagnosed with metastatic breast cancer that had gone to her hip bone. She is currently on a hormone therapy maintenance program and will be for the rest of her living years.

The Bettie Jane Cancer Foundation (BJCF) was born from the work and dedication of Bettie's students, friends and family that started a Walk to benefit the Cancer Care Center of Frederick. The foundation was officially established in 2011. Today, this non-profit organization, through walks and fundraising events throughout each year, provides support to cancer patients in need in Frederick, Washington, and Allegany Counties. The motto of the BJCF is "Working Together, Saving Lives!"
